Financial Strength

We have assets of \$6.3 billion CDN and liabilities of \$4.9 billion CDN². Our financial strength, as measured by A.M. Best Company, is rated "A" (Excellent) and has been for the past 10 years. This independent rating assesses our ability to pay claims and is an important measure of our strength and stability³.


Foresters conservative investment strategy has resulted in a strong surplus⁴ of \$1.4 billion CDN and the ability to withstand adverse business and market conditions. Our solvency ratios⁵ are well beyond the local regulatory requirements and above industry averages in all three countries in which we do business.

In 2010:

- 140,000 members took advantage of Foresters benefits of membership
- 108,000 members attended over 1,000 local events
- Over \$45 million was raised across North America through Foresters support as the founder and underwriter of the Radiothon program
- More than \$31.5 million was invested in programs that support our members, their benefits and their communities.

Best Company. In assigning Foresters rating, A.M. Best stated that Foresters rating outlook is "stable", which means it is unlikely to change in the near future, assuming Foresters financial strength is maintained and operations grow. A.M. Best assigns ratings from A++ to F, A++ being superior ratings and A and A- being excellent ratings. ⁴ This surplus represents excess funds above the amount required as legal reserves for insurance and annuity certificates in force and provides additional assurances to our members for our long term financial strength. ⁵ Solvency ratios indicate that our ability to meet long-term obligations is above and beyond what is required.
